The NCFMA Educational Committee met virtually for the third quarter on July 10, 2023.

The meeting was called to order by Tony Smart, Chair at 0903 AM. Those in virtual attendance were, Jeff Johnson, Charles Johnson, Charles Eldridge, Robert McSorley, Robert Carmon, Justin McLaurin, Tim Henshaw, and Eric Wiseman (check in).

Charles Johnson with OSFM provided an update(s) from the Code Consultation Division of OSFM. He had made contacts with the American Wood Council and Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition to assist with training at the FLSE Conference in Concord Feb. 28 thru March 1, 2024. He is awaiting confirmation regarding these classes.

Jeff Johnson with OSFM provided current information on the Fire Marshal 101 Class. A train-the-trainer session will be held in Fayetteville August 22-24, 2023. This class will be delivered regionally in "piloted" sessions beginning in the Fall of 2023 at present. The total number of hours for these classes is to be determined.

Jeff discussed additional responsibilities that will be undertaken regarding fire inspection schedules in the state. At present, there will be the need to gather data, and not audit for enforcement. Jurisdictions will be contacted to assist with this effort.

Chris Wells (along with Justin McLaurin and Ronnie Privette) has agreed to handle the public side of the website, and Thomas Raper continues to handle the private side.
