

On behalf of the North Carolina Fire Marshal's Association, the NC Fire Code Revision Committee is asking for letters of interest from the NCFMA membership to serve a term on the Revision Committee.

The NCFCRC is organized as a special committee under the North Carolina Fire Marshals Association (NCFMA) whose purpose is to enhance the technical requirements of the North Carolina Fire Code and secondarily to support code officials with review of proposed code changes. The committee shall pursue opportunities to improve and enhance the code as needed. This includes both the technical aspects of the codes as well as the code content in terms of scope and application of referenced standards. This is accomplished by submitting proposed code changes and participating in the code development process. This participation consists of supporting the proposed changes submitted as well as participating in the consideration of related changes proposed by others.

It is important to have diverse participation on this committee. All members of the NCFMA are encouraged to participate, this includes newer members. The committee is made up of 4 members from both the eastern and western regions and 6 members from the central region and Ex-Officio representatives.

Also attached to this email is a copy of the approved committee operating guidelines. Please note that the letter of interest must be accompanied by a letter of support from your supervisor. Committee service obligation is a term of four years, and attendance of quarterly meetings (scheduled one week prior to the NC Building Code Council meetings).
